



## OVERVIEW OF CURRENT RPS REZONING PROPOSALS

Richmond Public Schools is undergoing a district-wide rezoning project and your engagement is critical to a successful outcome. Please review the following proposed options for your region and share feedback on the attached thought catcher by Friday, October 11, 2019. ### CURRENT PROPOSALS FOR THE SOUTH SIDE REGION

#### South Elementary Options I and II:

- Both south side rezoning options similarly affect the zones of Blackwell ES, Greene ES, Broad Rock ES, Westover Hills ES, Southampton ES, and Miles Jones ES to balance utilization and alleviate overcrowding:
  - To alleviate overcrowding at Broad Rock ES, some Broad Rock ES students will be rezoned to Greene ES.
  - To help balance building utilization, some Westover Hills ES students (Woodland Heights neighborhood, east of Forest Hill Park) are rezoned to Blackwell ES.
  - To help balance building utilization, some Miles Jones ES students (near Carnation and Hioaks) are rezoned to Southampton ES.

#### South Middle School Option:

- Thompson MS is repurposed (future use TBD).
- All southern middle school attendance boundaries are rezoned to balance utilization, alleviate overcrowding, and align feeder patterns.

#### South High School Option:

- High school zones are modified to align feeder patterns.
- Overcrowding persists south of the river at the high school level and forecasts show overcrowding to worsen over the next 10 years.
