

Grades (Teachers)

1. Teachers will ONLY finalize grades for MP3 (NOT Semester 2).
2. Teachers will use the code "E" for EXEMPT in gradebook for all assignments that are missing for MP3.
3. Teachers will use 50% numerical value for all assignments that have a grade of "F" (meaning no score lower than 50%). This is for MP3 ONLY.
4. All updated grades are due May 8. (ASPEN is now open for MP2 and MP3.)
5. Final grades will be calculated in ASPEN using MP1, MP2, and MP3 ONLY.
6. There is a new MP3 grade input sheet that I will send to you via email (detailed instructions on how to complete all steps required).

Online Learning Modules

Let's breakdown what "modules" mean for the RPS @HOME platform.

- "Courses" on Edgenuity for non-AP core classes and certain electives
 - Fine arts "performance tasks" that will be submitted through specified links
 - CTE/Tech "coursework" that will be submitted through specified links
 - For AP, exams (for courses that have them) or work submitted to digital portfolios (for courses that do not have exams)
1. 9-11 grade students are required to complete learning modules for all courses in which they were enrolled at the closure of school to earn the credit for the class. (Modules will NOT be graded.) Seniors ONLY complete for classes they are failing.
 2. All students enrolled in AP courses with an exam MUST take the exam to earn course credit. All students enrolled in the following courses MUST instead submit work to their digital portfolios:
 - a. Computer Science Principles
 - b. Research
 - c. Seminar
 3. I have developed a team to evaluate what students are enrolled in to ensure students have enrolled in the correct courses.
 4. Students are able to request academic support via a link ("On-Demand Tutoring") on the RPS@HOME homepage: rpstech.org/parents.html
 5. There is a test at the end of each module that students are required to take for completion of the module. This is not for performance tasks which are listed for Pathway 2.
