***Flexible Learning Opportunities & Assistance Time:** Individualized learning support with specialized support staff (e.g., ESL teacher, exceptional education teacher, interventionist, tutor, counselor, social worker, CIS). Teachers may also use this time for family communication and 1:1 support.

Notes:

1. Middle School students enrolled in high school credit-bearing courses must be assigned an additional 75 minutes per week of asynchronous study to meet course clock hour requirements.
2. Blended instruction includes approximately a 50/50 mix of asynchronous and synchronous instruction but will vary based on the nature of each lesson. While the full class period does not need to be synchronous, the full time should be intentionally designed, and students should be assigned meaningful work throughout.
