




## RCMS Boundary Section 3 - Neighborhood View

#### RCMS Boundary Section 3 - Summary and Data




The northeast section of the River City Middle School zone extends east of Cowardin Avenue / US Rte 1 / US Rte 301. It includes the Manchester, Old Town Manchester, Blackwell, and Ancarrow's Landing neighborhoods, and portions of Oak Grove and Hillside Court. It is mostly within the Blackwell Elementary School zone; a small portion of Hillside Court is in the Oak Grove / Bellemeade Elementary School zone. The approximate center of Section 3 is approximately 5.5 miles from River City Middle School (driving).

Data for this section does not include school age students living in the zone who are not enrolled in RPS. RPS ES students may move, attend out-of-zone schools via Open Enrollment, or enroll in private or homeschool, when transitioning to middle school.





#### RCMS Boundary Section 4 - Summary and Data




The central-east section of the River City Middle School zone extends east of East Broad Rock Rd. It includes a number of neighborhoods - all of McGuire Veterans Hospital, Cofer, Cherry Gardens, and Broad Rock Industrial Park, and portions of Hickory Hill, McGuire, Deerbourne, and Jeff Davis. The approximate center of Section 4 is approximately 4.2 miles from River City Middle School (driving).

Data for this section does not include school age students living in the zone who are not enrolled in RPS. RPS ES students may move, attend out-of-zone schools via Open Enrollment, or enroll in private or homeschool, when transitioning to middle school.






The southeast section of the River City Middle School zone extends east of Broad Rock Rd. / Iron Bridge, south of Walmsley Blvd., and north of the southern city boundary. It includes the Cottrell Farms neighborhood and parts of Walmsley, Parnell Industrial Area, and Jeff Davis neighborhoods. The approximate center of Section 5 is approximately 3.5 miles from River City Middle School (driving).

Data for this section does not include school age students living in the zone who are not enrolled in RPS. RPS ES students may move, attend out-of-zone schools via Open Enrollment, or enroll in private or homeschool, when transitioning to middle school.




The southwest section of the River City Middle School zone extends west of Whitehead Road, south of US Rte 60 / Midlothian Trnpke., and east of the city boundary / Chippenham Pkway. It includes the Worthington neighborhood and parts of Midlothian and Elkhardt neighborhoods. The approximate center of Section 6 is approximately 1.4 miles from River City Middle School (driving). River City Midlde School is adjacent to the southeast corner of this section, though not within it.

Data for this section does not include school age students living in the zone who are not enrolled in RPS. RPS ES students may move, attend out-of-zone schools via Open Enrollment, or enroll in private or homeschool, when transitioning to middle school.


