Rossi Volley provided a brief scope of needs for the RFP. She specifically noted that training was an important aspect of the RFP. She stated that behavioral aides should come to the job with the training in place and be ready to deliver quality services.

The following questions were asked and answered:

O: Is this to be a multiple award?

A: Yes, we currently have 4 firms providing services that were awarded through an internal or cooperative contract. We expect this solicitation to be the same.

Q: Please clarify if additional assistance in toileting needs, tubes, etc. will be handled by the BA or nurse.

A: Basic toileting needs and regular daily activities will be assisted by the BA. Medical needs will be handled by a nurse.

Q: Data collection- Where should data be sent to...? A: Data should be sent to each individual school. The following questions were asked to be answered in writing: Q: How will BA absences and substitutes be handled?

Q: Would we have our staffed housed in the school daily?

Q: What behavioral assessments and interventions plans are currently being used?

Q: Would the interaction during the school day be a 1:1 ratio, or higher?

Q: For Personal care needs assistance, do our staff members need to be certified STNA's?

Q: How many exceptional students does the school district have that need this care? Due to small case ratio's, how many staff are they predicting?

Q: Evidence of successful completion of autism training, per the requirements under Va. Code §22.298.3. 2. Will this be offered through the school district or is this something we would need to do on our own?

Q: Evidence of successful completion of a formal de-escalation and restraint training (MANDT Preferred). Is this offered through the school district or would we need to have this training completed prior to the grant starting.

With no additional questions, the meeting ended.

Questions will be answered and posted to eVA and Bonfire weekly. Material changes to the solicitation will be issued via addendum.
